Details of key roles and responsibilities

1. Ensure compliance with the ASQ Document Management System (Operational and WHSE)

The Truck Driver/Loader Operator is responsible for complying with all ASQ policies and procedures according to our Operational and WHSE Management Systems.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Adhering to ASQ policies and procedures
- Compliance with the ASQ WHSE Management System (inductions, hazard reporting, take 5's, incident reporting, SWMS, risk assessments, RAC, SWP's, site inspections, subcontractor management, emergency response/code red, traffic management, first aid management, LOTO, participate in training etc.)
- Compliance with Chain of Responsibility, National Heavy Vehicle regulations and all state and federal road rules
- Understanding of compliance with PBS and NHVAS requirements (where applicable)
- Attending prestart meetings
- Attending toolbox talks

2. Loading, unloading and delivery of product

The Truck Driver/Loader Operator is responsible for providing a high level of customer service and the safe loading, unloading and delivery of product.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Asset management in OneHub (prestarts, faults, fuel entries etc.)
- Ensuring daily tasks are completed as directed by the Supervisor/Site Manager
- Providing a high level of customer service and the correct and appropriate advice is given, to the best of their ability
- Maintain a clean and orderly workplace
- Ensuring all vehicles are loaded safely and efficiently with the correct product at the correct weights and cubic metres (safe load requirements and accurate sale quantity)
- Ensuring the efficient delivery and unloading of the product at the location, as determined by the customer
- Communicating/reporting all issues with the Supervisor/Site Manager as required
- Ensuring any collection of money from customers on delivery is promptly returned to the yard office
- Completing all required documentation accordingly

3. General yard duties

The Truck Driver/Loader Operator is also responsible for maintaining loader and truck presentation as well as general yard duties as required.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Ensuring daily tasks are completed as directed by the Supervisor/Site Manager
- Maintaining presentation and cleanliness of the truck and loader
- Maintaining product bins and notifying the Supervisor/Site Manager of discrepancies with product being loaded/delivered
- Performing dust suppression duties by operating the water truck where required
- Performing yard tasks such as weeding, rubbish removal and general maintenance as required

4. Sales assistance

The Truck Driver /Loader Operator may also be required from time to time to assist in customer sales in the office.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Ensuring all customers are acknowledged and served in a timely manner (phone, email and in-store)
- Providing a high level of customer service and the correct and appropriate advice is given, to the best of their ability
- Ensuring daily tasks are completed as directed by the Supervisor/Site Manager
- Ensuring the daily operation of the site runs according to standard procedures/tasks (such as sales/purchases/transfers, customer deliveries/truck scheduler etc.)
- Maintain a clean and orderly workplace
- Attend Garden & Landscape meetings as required
